

Dzierżoniów Awarded the Polish Economy



Dzierżoniów has been awarded the Polish Economy Diamond 2025 title by the Institute of European Business. In this year's ranking, Dzierżoniów placed 111th out of 1,026 cities in Poland, ranking among the 323 municipalities that received this distinction.

Dzierżoniów's high ranking was driven by the presence of 34 companies with an estimated market value exceeding PLN 10 million each. The growth and strength of these businesses are key factors behind the city's robust local economy and its position in the nationwide ranking. The ranking was compiled based on an analysis of publicly available financial data from companies registered in the National Court Register (KRS). The market value of the companies was estimated using valuation methods commonly applied to companies listed on the Warsaw Stock Exchange.

The award confirms Dzierżoniów's strong economic potential and the presence of dynamic, growing businesses that create jobs and contribute to the development of the local economy. It also reflects the city's long-term commitment to supporting entrepreneurship, attracting investment, and fostering a business-friendly environment.

What is the Polish Economy Diamonds ranking?

The Polish Economy Diamonds 2025 ranking is prepared annually by the Institute of European Business. This year's edition assessed the economic performance of 1,026 Polish cities, with 323 municipalities receiving the prestigious title.

The distinction is awarded to municipalities where at least 10 companies operate with an estimated market value exceeding PLN 10 million each. The aim of the ranking is to identify local governments with strong economic potential and an environment that supports business growth and investment.
